

## What is 3C Rehab?

**3C Rehab** is an **inpatient program for veterans who need therapy to gain strength and skills after an illness or injury.**

**3C Rehabilitation (3C Rehab)** is located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of the VA Towbin Healthcare Center (sometimes called Fort Roots VA) in North Little Rock, Arkansas.




## Medical Problems Served

Individualized programs are available to provide targeted treatment for a variety of medical conditions including, but not limited to:

- Stroke/neurological disorders
- Deconditioning
- Orthopedic surgery
- Major Fractures
- Spinal cord injury
- Multiple trauma
- Amputation
- Brain injury
- GuillianBarre
- Burns

A full complement of medical services including x-ray, lab, and pharmacy are available 24/7 on 3C rehab. Special imaging / specialist consults are seen in LR VA. Urgent/emergent care requires transfer to LR acute hospital. 3C averaged 1.4 unplanned transfers to the LR hospital per month in FY 12.

## The Program

The veteran is expected to participate in an intensive rehab program which requires up to three hours of therapy each day.

Therapy times will be scheduled daily and communicated to you. Skills learned in therapy gym should be practiced on the ward.

Rehabilitation activities continue through the weekend while in hospital. Weekend passes home may be scheduled before your discharge to practice living and evaluate your function in the home setting.

Bring comfortable clothing, personal care items and supportive shoes.

## Your Rehab Goals

- **To gain strength and independence**
- **To maintain safety in life activities**
- **To give your family skills to help you with recovery**

## Program Results

Our patients show gains equivalent to other rehab units and the majority return to their home after discharge.

Home	71%
Nursing Home	13.5 %
Hospital or other	15.5 %

After discharge from 3C, most patients maintain their abilities.

Response to survey questions:

Survey contracted through MedTel, an independent non-governmental data collection agency and reported to 3C Rehab quarterly

I was satisfied with the treatment I received on 3C Rehab. (73%*)	93%
I was involved with decision making during my rehabilitation. (70%*)	90%
The rehabilitation program prepared me for going home. (66%*)	93%
The progress I made met my expectations. (70%*)	90%
The rehabilitation program improved my quality of life. (72%*)	94%
My social activity level is similar to before my rehab stay. (51%*)	72%


